- Declining enrollment is going to shift how we approach teaming next year for 7th grade. 8th grade, for the most part, will continue to loop with their students; however, there will be some shifts with some teachers due to specific needs related to courses and teaming. I will send a letter out to parents explaining all of this mid-May and what changes to expect for 2018-2019.
- PARCC testing went very well. Although it was long, the students maintained great attitudes throughout the testing and our hope is that our students have shown growth from last year. There is a lot of divided conversation around PARCC still, however the test will be one indicator of how our students are growing. The test isn't going away and as we develop our ECRISS database for our students, creating personalized learning profiles, PARCC will be one measures we use to determine whether our students are proficient in



meeting the standards.

- Please make sure 8th grade parents are reviewing the Friday Flyer messages that are being sent out as there is quite a bit of information for end-of-the-year activities including the dance and graduation.
- We completed team talks for our 7th and 8th grade students and have reminded our students of academic and behavioral expectations. Mr. Field and I have created a 3-strike policy for students ,which may eliminate an opportunity for students to participate in an activity with their grade level. As the weather warms up and summer draws near, it's important to keep our kids focused as much as possible to the end of the school year. We hope that you will support our message to them at home.
- Any current 6th or 7th grade students who are enrolled in Algebra 1 this year, we will be holding a math meeting for next year's math placement process into AAA or AATH on May 3rd at noon in the lecture room on the west side. Parents and students are invited to attend. For those who cannot make it, we will provide our presentation through the Friday Flyer.
